SCRATCH AND PERFORMANCE RACING

The winter racing was dominated by light southerly breezes in June and July with stronger westerlies in August. Two regattas were abandoned due to lack of wind, one due to heavy rain and one was lost due to extreme conditions.

After 9 regattas and 3 drops Dave Anstey was a close winner on scratch. Terry Farrell sailed consistently to finish second and Brad Quiggan was third.

The performance racing was closely contested with Brad Quiggan first, just ahead of Dave Anstey second with Keith Albury third.

PURSUIT RACING

An afternoon with a light easterly breeze saw Adam Cooke as the winner followed by Markus Schumi, Marshall Harper and Dave Anstey equal second. The pointscore is now available on the website and Richard Orrell has now established himself as the frontrunner for this series. Les McPherson and Marshall Harper are coming second and third.
