



VX ONE 2019 NSW State Titles 9th – 10th November 2019

NOTICE OF RACE

1. INVITATION

1.1 Lake Macquarie Yacht Club as the organising authority invites entries from eligible yachts to compete in the 2019 VX One NSW State Titles to be held on Lake Macquarie on Saturday 9th November and Sunday 10th November 2019.

2. RULES

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 – 2020 and to the 2017 VX One Class Rules.

2.2 Attention is to be taken to VX One Class Rules B1.1(c), and C5.1

2.3 Where there is conflict with the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail except that neither shall change nor alter any Class Rules.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 Entries are to be made **via the TOP Yacht Entry System**

3.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10m.

3.3 All participants will comply with 2017-2020 AS Special Regulations. The Equipment Audit Form Part 2.

4. **FEES**

4.1 Entry fee is \$250 per boat

5. **SCHEDULE**

5.1 Racing will be a series of up to 8 races conducted over two days from Saturday 9th November to Sunday 10th November 2019 with a mix of one and two lap durations.

Saturday 9th November – Races 1 to 4 commencing at 12:00pm

Sunday 10th November – Races 5 to 8 commencing at 11:00am

Registration will be from 9am to 10am on Saturday 9th November 2019.

5.2 A competitors briefing will be held at 10.30am on Saturday 9th November 2019.

5.3 No race will be started after 4.30pm on any day of the regatta and after 2.00pm on the Sunday.

5.4 If conditions/time permit, an extra race may be conducted on the Saturday

6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

6.1 The sailing instructions will be available by 1500 on Friday 25th October 2019 from the LMYC web site <https://lmyc.com.au/sailing-instructions/> Regatta Sailing Instructions heading.

7. **THE COURSES**

7.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward.

8. **THE SCORING**

8.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.

8.2 Four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

8.3 When seven (7) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. **HAUL OUT**

9.1 Boats may haul out at the end of each day's racing.

9.2 An area immediately in front of the Club (Marina side) will be reserved for boats that prefer to overnight in the water.

10. **PRIZES**

10.1 Prizes will be given to first, second and third overall.

11. **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

11.1 Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk and responsibility.

11.2 By lodging an entry, participants agree that they will release, hold harmless and indemnify Lake Macquarie Yacht Club, their officials and other organisers from liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

11.3 Attention is drawn to AS Fundamental Rules 3, Acceptance of the Rules and 4, Decision to Race.
