SCRATCH AND PERFORMANCE RACING

February racing began with moderate north east sea breezes then finished with lighter south easterly breezes and a fickle north westerly breeze.

After 11 regattas and 3 drops Brad Quiggan won the summer series beating Dave Anstey and Paul Morrish who tied for second place. In the performance racing Paul Morrish sailed consistently to finish first, ahead of Jim Orrell, with Adam Cooke third.

In the yearly pointscore series Brad Quiggan has established a solid lead over Dave Anstey second, with Paul Morrish third. In a closely contested performance competition Jim Orrell leads Paul Morrish followed by Clive Dutton third.

PURSUIT RACING

The seventeenth and eighteenth rounds of the Orrell Cup were sailed on the 4th and 18th of March. The days winners were Brad Quiggan and Paul Morrish (equal first) and Marshall Harper. Marshall Harper has regained the lead in this series but is being challenged by Dave Anstey, Paul Morrish, Brad Quiggan and Clive Dutton. We are threequarters of the way through this series and all of the above competitors have a chance to become the overall winner.
