SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Rules

- 1.1 The race will be sailed under the current Racing Rules of Sailing and the current Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia.
- 1.2 The Special Regulations of Australian Sailing for Category 7 races shall apply.
- 1.3 A yacht shall each carry a current third party insurance cover in the sum of \$10,000,000
Only a yacht complying with these conditions are considered as entrants.
- 1.4 The race will be conducted under TCF conditions with competitors being allocated to group starts determined by the Racing Committee.
- 1.5 All boats shall carry a VHF radio (minimum 5 watt) and tuned to channel 71.

Briefing

- 2.1 Guests and Skippers will meet in the Clubhouse from 1230
Briefing for Skippers and guests will be at 1300

Start/Finish Line

- 3.1 The start/finish line will be a line drawn between the Race Committee Box (RCB) on the SW corner of the LMYC marina and the Start/Finish mark (Marks). A lime green inner distance mark shall be taken on the same hand as the RCB when starting or finishing.

Recalls

- 4.1 Individual Recalls shall be in accordance with RRS 29.
In addition the Race Officer (RO) may broadcast on VHF radio (Chan 71) the sail number of a boat that is On Course Side (OCS). A failure to make such broadcast or to receive such broadcast will not be considered as grounds for redress.
(Changes RRS 62.1(a))













Marks

- 5.1 All marks (except shorten course mark) including the Start/finish mark shall be LMYC permanent marks – a lime green cylinder approximately 1.2 m high x 300mm diameter with a red band and a yellow cone atop. Pulbah Island and Wangi Point are the landforms so named.
- 5.2 Shorten course mark: Galgabba (WASC) lime green cylinder 1.2m high x 300 mm diameter with black band near waterline.

Communications

- 6.1 A boat retiring before, during or after a race shall notify the RC of its intention to do so by calling the RO on mobile: 0414 450 022 or VHF (Channel 71) at the earliest opportunity. The boat will be DNF. (Changes RRS 63.1 and A4)
Any boat retiring from a race and failing to advise the RC will be scored DNC. (Changes RRS 63.1 and A5.3)

8.1 The course to be sailed will be indicated by a numeral pennant displayed from the RCB at the warning signal:-

All cardinal marks encountered on the course shall be passed on the prescribed hand.

Shortened Course

9.1 If “S” Flag is displayed on the Flag staff at the Race Control Box (before warning signal), Course will be shortened so that “GALGABBA” mark (WASC), replaces Pulbah Island and SRM, and shall be left to PORT (P) when rounding. (Galgabba location is approximately midway between Wangi Point and Pulbah Island).

Race results and scoring

10.1 Results will be calculated on TCF handicap with the lowest corrected time scored first, the next lowest corrected time second, and so on. (Refer RRS A4, A5.2)

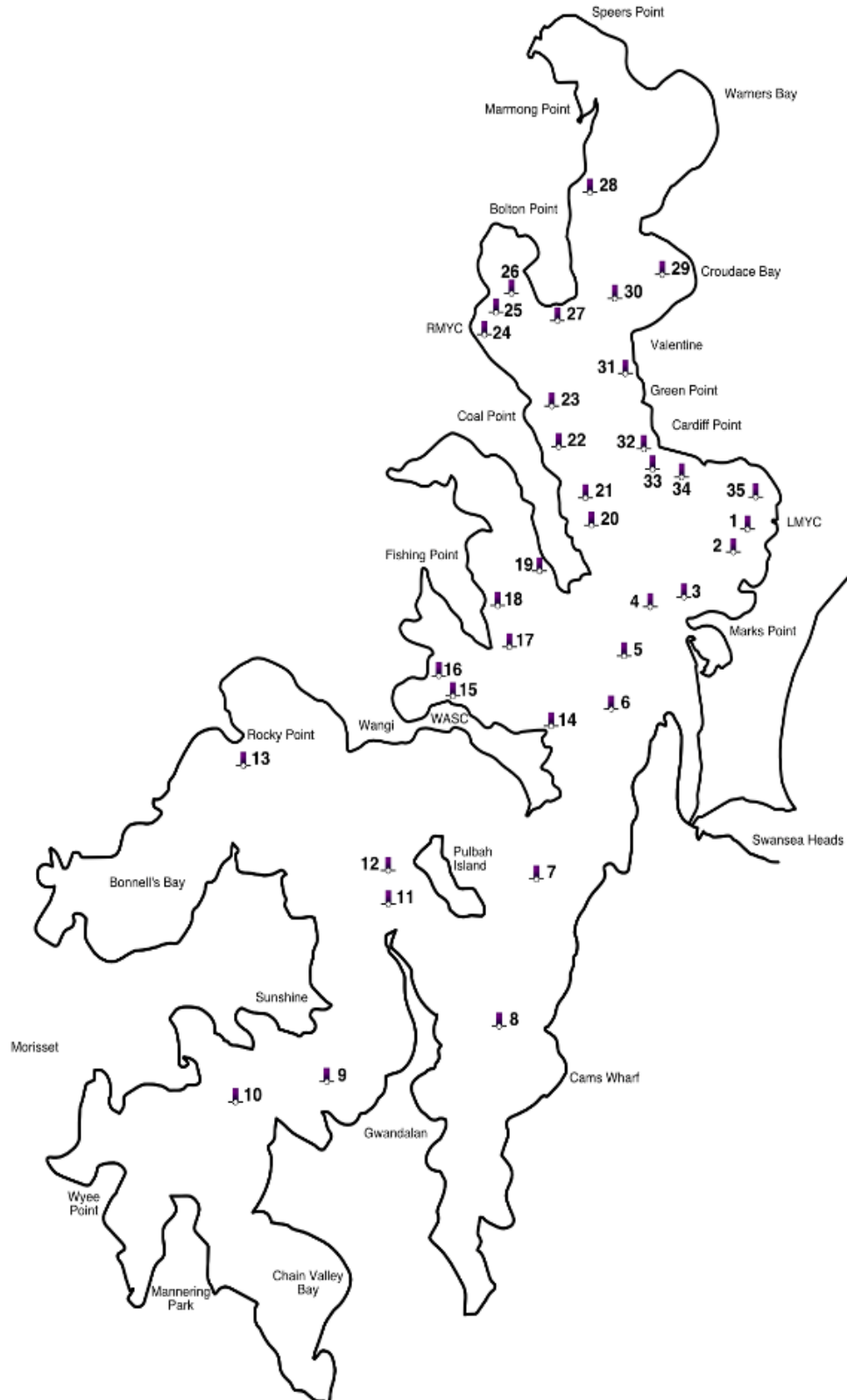
Prizes
